

Some minor repairs are taking place in the church, sacristy and a new carpet is to be laid in a few days on the sanctuary.

In St. Joseph's work will soon begin on the potholes around the grounds, as well as repairs to the roof of the Church. A few days ago, a new hearing system was fitted along with the loop system for the hard of hearing which I hope will be of help to us all.
